RELEASE WEEKEND OCTOBER 28TH

The release of SERFF v5 is just a few short months away. Originally planned for a July debut, the release has been rescheduled to the weekend of October 28. The extra three months allows for coding of the required functionality and thorough testing.

On October 30, all SERFF users will log into v5 via a new URL. All users will be accessing the application on an NAIC server. Details on how and where to log in will be released in the coming weeks, along with other important information to prepare users for the big day.
