- Self-service user management to reduce wait and improve security




#### **Release Weekend**

   Project team begins code deployments and data migration
   Project team will verify migration and deployment success
- Systems unavailable for ALL users during release window
- By Monday at 7 am CT, new platform opened for use, legacy SERFF back online




#### Introduce

#### Q&A

- Q: Will users be able to still use the legacy platform once the new platform goes live?
  - A: Once a business type is moved to the new platform, users will complete work for that business type only in the new platform.
- Q: Will pre-November Compact filings still be visible in 'old' SERFF for reference?
  - A: Yes, but they will be changed to 'read only'.
- Q: Will there be training sessions offered for user once the new platform is live?
  - A: We will evaluate this after training for the first release has been completed.
- Q: Will the written and recorded materials be posted on the NAIC website for access?
  - A: The exact location is being determined, but the materials will be available to SERFF users.
- Q: When will dates for the industry user training be announced?
  - A: By the week of 9/23
- Q: How will the public portal be updated as each line is released? Will there be two platforms?
  - A: Yes, there will be two public portal platforms for a period. We are developing a new public portal, so business types will move to the new portal as they are moved to the new platform.

- Q: For PSU migration, is there a possibility of losing updated data or audit trail?
  - A: No, the updated data and history of those changes will be migrated along with other filing data.
- Q: Will we be able to see approved filings from last year in the new system?
  - A: Yes, all closed and open filings will be migrated. Draft filings will not be migrated.
- Q: If you don't want to use AI, can you turn it off?
  - A: We are still having discussions on this topic.
- Q: Will AWS potentially have access to confidential company data in SERFF?
  - A: We are still having discussions on this topic.
- Q: How will the AI work with the recent notice from the NAIC about generative AI issues?
  - A: This is too broad a question to answer. If the person who asked wants to reach out, we would be happy to have a discussion.
- Q: Will Templates transfer over?
  - A: Not in Release 1.
- Q: Will the structure of pdf pipelines be impacted?
  - A: Yes, the structure of the pdf will change because there have been changes to the filing structure, but we don't anticipate a change in the level of content included in the pdf.
- Q: Will the Insurance Summit workshop be recorded?
  - A: No
